WHO: Summer 2007 play is open only to WFHA members. A WFHA member is someone who paid dues during the fall 2006 season or indoor 2007 season. The reason for this is limited space and expected popularity. Any extra spots will be open to non-members.

COST: The cost is \$55 per person for all 6 sessions. Registration will close at 40 players (first 40 will be registered) or on Thursday, June 7th, whichever comes first. Act fast to reserve your spot!

HOW TO REGISTER:

1. Complete and **sign** registration form- You MUST be a US Field Hockey Member to play.

3. **DETAILS:** We will be using one regulation turf field to play full field hockey. Teams will be made each Sunday. Each player MUST be a current US Field Hockey Assoc. member and must provide their membership number upon registration. Please do not mail in an incomplete registration form. Incomplete forms will be returned to sender. Each player must bring their own hockey stick, shoes suitable for turf, a dark and light shirt, mouthguards and shinguards.

There are no refunds for cancellations due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances. University of Maryland, George Mason University, and WFHA reserve the right to cancel play at their discretion.

DIRECTIONS:

University of Maryland: Take Exit 25B off 495, College Park, Route 1 South. After approximately one mile, take a right-hand exit off of US 1 and onto Route 193 West. At the first traffic light, turn LEFT into Campus. The Comcast Center will be on your right. After you pass the softball field on the right, pull into the first parking lot on the right that you come to. The fields are on the right along the lot. You can park right in front of the fields.

George Mason University: (From Baltimore and points north using 495 and 66) Take I-95 South. Take exit 27 -- I-495 West (sign will say Silver Spring). Take Exit 49A - I-66 West (toward Front Royal). Take Exit 60 - 123 South (toward Fairfax). Go through 6 traffic lights. At 7th light take a right onto University Drive. Make a Left on Rapidan River Road (approximately 250 yards past the Field House, George Mason Stadium and the Varsity Baseball Field). Go to field #3 (immediately after softball field).

US Field Hockey Association. Waiver and Release of Liability

In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in the USFHA programs, related events and activities, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates and willingly agrees that:
